**Other relevant information:**

- The proposal was already discussed in the UAC meeting on 10.02.2022 (agenda item No.3) and it was decided that the unit shall submit Encumbrance Certificate issued by AP Registration dept. Govt. of A.P. and to obtain the value of EPCG goods to be taken into EOU scheme as per Customs Act/Rules.
- The Unit submitted the EC copy which showed that the proposed land on which the EOU is proposed was in favour of the unit in its earlier name.
- The Jurisdictional Customs vide letter dt.24.03.2022 submitted inspection report and informed that the assessable value of EPCG goods is Rs.26.01.00.050 and as per their records there are no revenue implications against the Unit noticed.
- The Jurisdictional DGFT vide their letter dt.26.10.2021 had already agreed provisionally for EPCG goods transfer to EOU scheme and requested for copy of LoP to finalize the case as per Appendix 6M(4) of FTP for the said transfer.
